MEASURE Z: CITIZEN'S MEDICAL CANNABIS BUSINESS INITIATIVE OF 2017 Shall the citizen measure authorizing the commercial storefront retail sales of medicinal cannabis by up to 11 retailers in the City of Vista	
to be located in any of Vista's commercial, industrial, business park, and mixed use zoning districts; imposing a 7% special use tax on gross receipts potentially raising \$117,600 per dispensary annually until ended by voters; be adopted?	NO

MEASURE AA: CITY COUNCIL CANNABIS BUSINESS TAX Shall the City Council measure imposing a general tax on potential future cannabis businesses to offset their community impacts by taxing marijuana cultivation at \$14/square foot; and gross receipts of marijuana businesses at rates not	YES
