- According to the latest information from the National Survey on Drug Use and Health (NSDUH)
- •19.7 million American adults (aged 12 and older) battled a substance use disorder in 2017.1
- •Almost 74% of adults suffering from a substance use disorder in 2017 struggled with an alcohol use disorder.<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>
- •About 38% of adults in 2017 battled an illicit drug use disorder.<sup>1</sup>

Every day, more than 130 people in the United States die after overdosing on opioids. The misuse of and addiction to opioids including prescription pain relievers, heroin, and synthetic opioids such as fentanyl—is a serious national crisis that affects public health as well as social and economic welfare.


- •In 2017, 1 out of every 8 adults struggled with both <u>alcohol and drug use disorders simultaneously</u>.<sup>1</sup>
- •In 2017, 8.5 million American adults suffered from both a mental health disorder and a substance use disorder, or co-occurring disorders.<sup>1</sup>
- •Drug abuse and addiction cost American society more than \$740 billion annually in lost workplace productivity, healthcare expenses, and crime-related costs.<sup>2</sup>





One in every 12 adults, or 17.6 million people, suffer from alcohol use disorder or alcohol dependence.





Addiction costs the economy \$190 billion annually.





People die each year from alcohol related causes.





\$11 saved for every \$1 spent on prevention.





21 million Americans suffering from untreated addiction.





23 million americans living in recovery from an addiction.


