8:00 AM **Minutes of the General Membership –Video Conference via Zoom**
Thursday, November 12, 2020

Attendance:

27 attendees joined the meeting via Zoom link; meeting facilitated by Aaron Byzak, NCPC President.

I. Welcome and Introductions: *Aaron Byzak.*

II. Meeting Minutes Approval: *October 8, 2020.*
Meeting minutes were accepted into the record as presented.

III. Treasurer’s Report: *Diane Strader, Treasurer.*

IV. 2021 NCPC Board of Directors Election – Open seats:
Aaron reported there are two open board seats for 2021/2022 term. If anyone is available and interested in volunteering in the capacity, please contact any NCPC board member. Self-nominations are welcome; election will be held in December.

V. Program Presentation: VCC Tobacco Control Program, Lisa Archibald, Program Manager:
Lisa reported that it has been a “banner year” for tobacco control programs in North San Diego County, and noted that the Escondido City Council recently, unanimously, approved Tobacco Retail License Ordinance. Lisa shared a PowerPoint presentation including review of VCC’s tobacco program background and tobacco team updates, policy and project accomplishments for 2020, and outlined policy objectives for 2021.

VI. NCPC Program Updates – Erica Leary, Program Manager:

- Oceanside Youth group continues to hold ZOOM meetings and met with State Rep. Tasha Hoerner-Horvath to discuss MJ policy concerns.
- Sticker Shock Campaign has been redesigned to collaborate with Zappy’s Pizza Restaurant to put Social Host stickers on take-out order pizza boxes.
- Rx Drug Take Back Day – very successful, 741 lbs. of drugs collected at the North County TCMC drop-off location.
- The Oceanside Chamber of Commerce hosted two podcast presentations, one with Aaron Byzak and John Byrom discussing Opioid addiction and the county’s Fentanyl alert; the second with youth coalition members discussing concerns regarding MJ policy and youth access.
- NCPC’s December 10th general meeting will include a visit with General Barrye Price, President and CEO of Community Anti-Drug Coalitions of America (CADCA).
