The board discussed inviting a local tobacco prevention speaker who could address this issue and the overlapping issue of marijuana legalization. Aaron suggested Bonnie Preston, a regional representative with the federal Health and Human Services; Ray Thomson also suggested a brainstorming session to discuss 4/20 event and how Prop 64 will impact our event message.
