III. Discussion/Program Updates:

Vista Beer Run: Erica Leary.

Erica reported that the Vista Chamber of Commerce is sponsoring the first annual 5K "Vista Beer Run" on October 22 (no age limit). Event marketing states that *all race finishers will be given their first beer <u>free</u> (21+). Event parking has been approved by the Vista School District for runners to use the RBVHS parking lot.*

Erica shared a letter written by members of the Rancho Buena Vista High School Public Policy Club expressing their "strong opposition" to the event and its focus around alcohol consumption. The letter cites recent death of an RBV parent killed by a drunk driver who had been drinking at a Vista microbrewery prior to the crash. Club members feel that this event with its focus on alcohol is "irresponsible and insensitive" on the part of event organizers. The letter also outlined the student's requests on how the event might be modified to promote a healthier, family friendly event (e.g. rename the event so the focus is not alcohol, offer non-alcoholic beverages to all race finishers, incorporate strong prevention messages to prevent underage drinking, drinking and driving, and over consumption of alcohol).

Board members reviewed the club's letter and discussed event logistics/marketing campaign and unanimously agreed it was a "bad idea." The short time frame before the actual event date was noted and members discussed how NCPC could still offer support to the club. The final consensus was that NCPC officially supports the opposition expressed by the PP club and agreed that NCPC should
